Cross Cultures uses sports to promote peace and social cohesion. It was founded in 1998 in Bosnia-Herzegovina, and its flagship program is the Open Fun Football Schools (OFFS). The OFFS program brings together children and youth from different ethnic, social, and religious backgrounds to play football and learn about cooperation and respect.

The OFFS program has been implemented in 23 countries (of which 17 are active today), reaching **over 1.8 million direct beneficiaries**, including **104,000 volunteers**.

Idea:

The program's core assumption is that winning a war is feasible, but achieving lasting peace is not. True peace must be cultivated within individuals, among people, within institutions, and across social structures.

Cross Cultures uses Fun Sports activities to bring children, youth and adults living in conflict-sensitive areas together to communicate, interact, play, and collaborate across ethnic, social and religious divides. Cross Cultures' Fun Sports approach creates a "safe space" within the conflict that breaks down barriers between people by allowing them to form new perspectives and develop positive relationships that can grow outside the football field. Cross Cultures programs include the Youth Leadership Education, which trains young volunteers to become Community Organizers and involves localized add-ons that match the specific context.

(3)*: FutbolNet Program:

FutbolNet program funded by FC Barcelona is a program of education of values through sport. It is a proposal designed to educate children and teenagers with values through sporting practice linked to football, favoring experiences of human development in contexts identified as a priority for social and community intervention.
