As the head of the team we are responsible for finalizing shop drawings dealing with all kind of poles, road engineering and lately high tower satellites, and all the work and redlines are submitted through Dropbox.

Starting early this year with Allied Consulting Company – Downtown Beirut, I was hired as a contractor mainly dealing with all kind of finishes besides doing architect's jobs and visiting sites for inspection and control.

I was the person who submits prices and BOQs (cooperating with Italians) regarding towers, beach resorts and hotels (ex: Dophin Hotel – Ashrafieh, Stone 55 – Zalka etc..)
